All students from Year 3-8 use a Google account and a digital device as a tool for learning. We encourage parents to purchase their child a device of their own to use at school. Each class has one Chromebook and between five and eight ipads that are for children that do not have their own device. The preferred device is a Chromebook for the reasons outlined below:

- They have exceptional battery life - up to 8 hours.
- Students learning is saved to their unique Google Account. It is saved as they type so they don't have to worry about losing it.
- Learning is saved online not to the individual computer. This means that they can access it on any device by logging into their Google account.
- They are small, light and well priced.
- No other programmes can be downloaded to the Chromebook. This means fewer distractions.
- They are less prone to viruses.
- They are automatically updated.

If your child has another laptop or tablet, they are more than welcome to bring it instead. We recommend that you purchase a keyboard for tablets. Laptops must have sufficient battery life to last for the duration of the school day.
